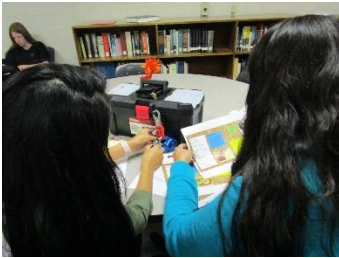


Media Report- First Nine Weeks, 2018-19
